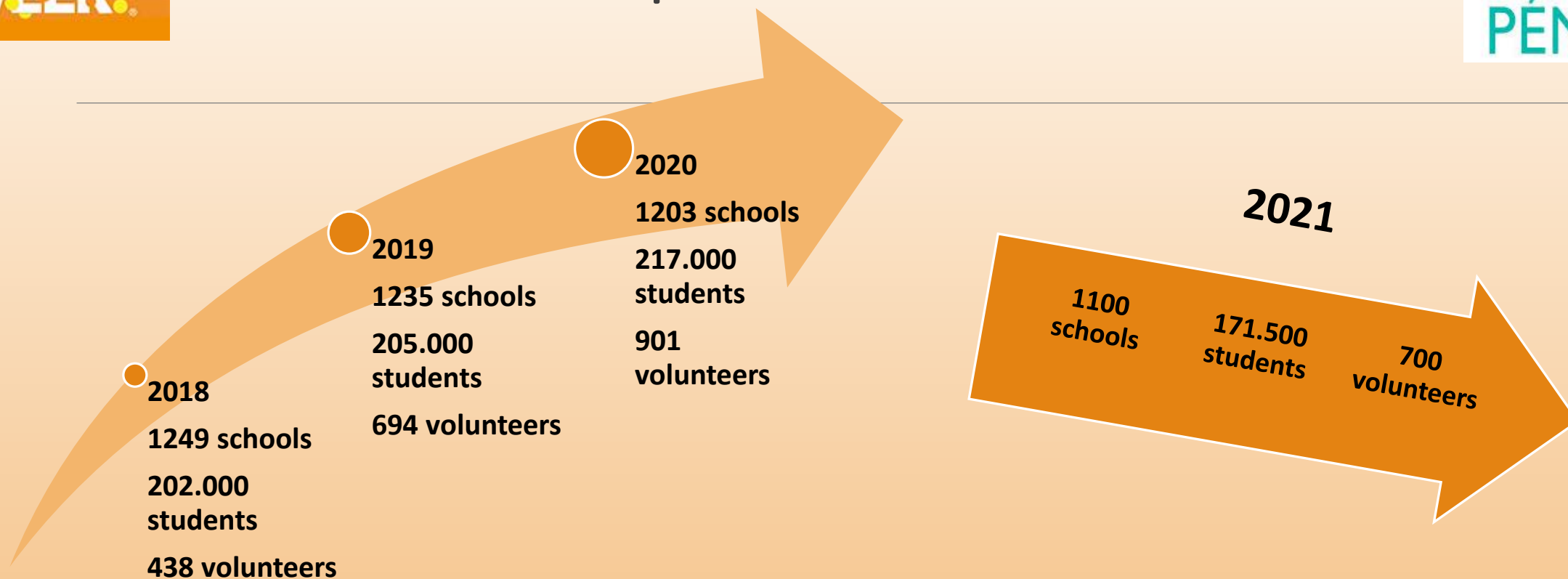

Participation trends



Due to the increasing pandemic situation in Hungary, the number of participants decreased. Educators had the possibility to postpone the Money-week until the end of the academic year.

Online participation

- Three quarter of teachers prefer personal attendance of volunteers.
- 40-50% of the volunteers could take the opportunity of online platform with regards both the number of classes and the easiness of getting in touch with small-city schools.

Online behaviour of students

The ability of raising students' attention has been considered fairly good by all the responding groups, whereas students' attitude shows medium or weak results.

Unfortunately, online classes could not provide as many interactions with the students as the offline ones.

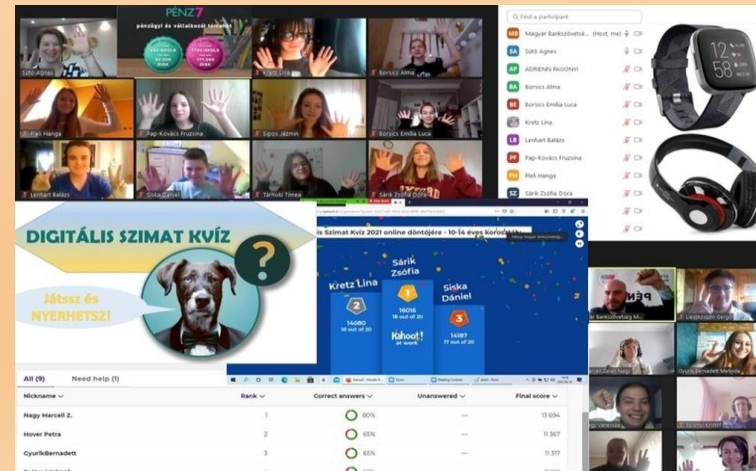

Offering ICT tools, Kahoot – Quiz and programmes

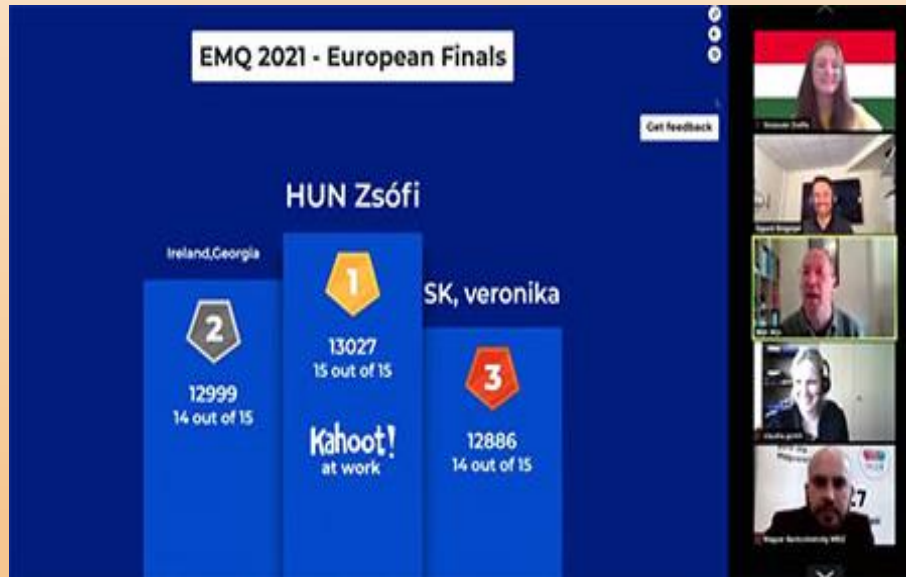
- ICT tool usage and Kahoot Quiz are rapidly increasing year by year and these results are the best since we started measuring them 3 years ago.

Overall evaluation – good, excellent ratings

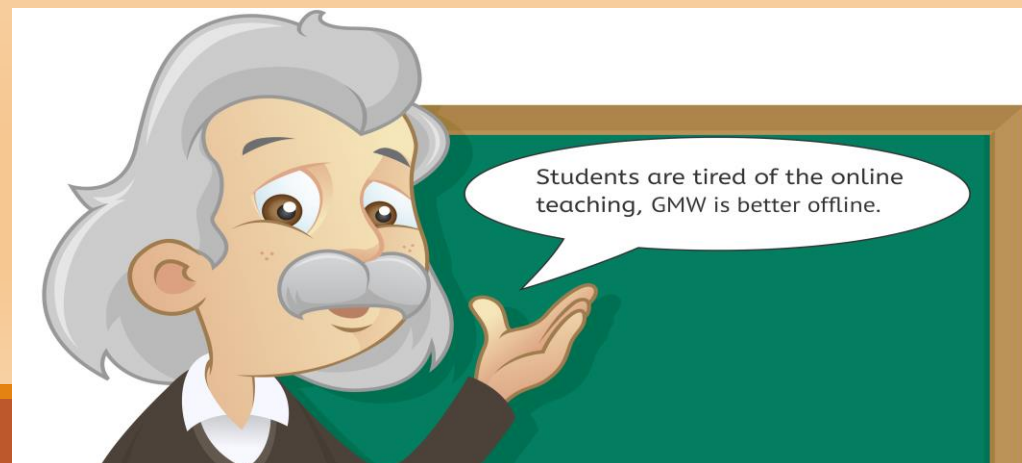
